HB 4015 - Rep. Conlin, J. (D - Ann Arbor) - This bill sets a \$50 limit on a co-pay for a 30 day supply of prescription insulin.

HB 4620 - Rep. Edwards, K. (D - Eastpointe) - This bill prohibits denying coverage for preexisting conditions, and prohibits canceling coverage based on the health of the insured.
